

Judges Compensation

Version November 2025

In order to standardize the judges compensation for the upcoming competitions we suggest that we follow the way it is done at KNGU competitions, namely:

During the competition a form will be passed around to the judges where they can write down their travelled kilometers by car which can then be used to calculate the compensation they receive at a rate of €0.23 per kilometer, or if travelled with public transport the costs made for transport there and back. To see an example of the sheet used for this please look at the so named example in this folder.

Furthermore, the judges should receive a lunch during the day from the association, and have some snacks and water provided.

The financing of the costs of the judges compensation can be completed through a similar fashion as is done for the compensation of the jury courses. Please refer to the part below for information related to this.

Whenever a competition committee has set a participation fee for their competition, a so-called "jury fee" will be added. This will be a maximum of €0,50 per participant per competition, and will be communicated between the NSTB board and the organizing association/committee. In the year 2025/2026 this amount is set at €0,25 per participant. The fee will be included in the usual participation fee, so it will be paid to the organizing association. It does not necessarily need to be communicated to the participants that they are paying for this fee, and it also does not have to be mentioned separately on the invoice to the sister associations.

After the competition has taken place, the NSTB will send an invoice to the organizing association. The amount of the invoice is the total collected jury fee, which is equal to the jury fee multiplied by the number of participants. This only includes the people that participate in the competition, so it is unrelated to participation in dinner, party, and sleepover.

With an average of 200 participants per competition, the jury fund can be filled quickly and easily. Also, the value of the jury fee can be adjusted per competition, depending on the demand and necessity.

Conditions for compensation

Student jury members attend a jury course at KNGU and initially pay for their own active KNGU membership. Once they have obtained their diploma and **have judged at least 2 NSTB competitions**, they can submit a reimbursement form to NSTB, with the costs shown in the table below. They must also provide any **evidence of their (past or current) membership in a student gymnastics association.**

Amount of compensation

The reimbursement amount is equal to the KNGU contribution they paid during the time they

were doing their jury course. For each diploma, there is a minimum number of sessions that the trainee jury member must attend. These sessions take place weekly. This means the following:

*Costs based on the KNGU contribution in 2025/2026
